At Pinecrest School, standardized tests are one of many ways we assess student performance. In order to gauge individual student growth, curriculum effectiveness and school-wide success, student progress is assessed regularly by a variety of means. Through daily informal assessment, anecdotal records, portfolios, running records, work samples, ongoing curriculum testing, and standardized testing, teachers continually monitor performance and curriculum.

The use of a norm-referenced achievement test such as the Stanford 10 allows our faculty and administration to compare Pinecrest students to a representative sample of public school students the same age and grade. Typically, our students achieve high scores as a result of many factors, one of which we believe is the exposure to so many unique learning opportunities and experiences at Pinecrest School. The scores and percentages indicated on this chart represent the average performance of students tested in a given month of the school year.

The scores on this chart represent one class of fourth graders (6 students total) and one class of sixth graders (4 students total) who took the test in 2013. At Pinecrest School, we take great pride in our students' achievement and growth. Our students always impress us, and these standardized test scores are no exception.

The interpretation of the test data below shows how the average score of Pinecrest students on each subtest compares to scores of students nationally. For example, on the fourth grade test, the *Total Reading* subtest score shows that 78% of all fourth graders taking the test nationally scored lower than the average Pinecrest student.
